HUD 2007 Targeted Housing and Homeless Assistance SuperNOFA

In the March 13, 2007 edition of the *Federal Register*, HUD announced \$1.25 billion in competitive homeless assistance funds. McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Grant applications are due June 8, 2006.

Major Changes for 2007

(from the March 13, 2007 *Federal Register*, p. 11743 - page 310 in Acrobat Reader)

This list includes all major changes to the CoC NOFA:

a. As in past years, CoCs who would like to create new permanent housing units may use the "hold harmless reallocation process" to do so. With this process, eligible CoCs can replace or reduce renewal projects with a new permanent housing project using the same funds. In the past, a CoC risked losing the funds that it had "reallocated" in this way if the CoC did not score above the full funding line. New this year, CoCs who are in "hold harmless status" who seek to use the reallocation process to create new permanent housing units may do so without risk of losing the reallocated amount. If a CoC reallocates a portion of its pro rata need to an eligible new permanent housing project, the project will be funded, even if it is a lower-rated eligible project as long as it is in a
